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#### 前言

這本書記錄了我們在過去十個月訓練歷程中的 一點一滴。縱然本屆計劃已經順利完結,但希 望此書能讓我們回憶起這段日子的得著,時刻 提醒我們作為青年使者的使命,保持埋藏在心 底的恩慈和良善。



#### **Foreword**

In December 2014, a group of Young Envoys kick-started their journey to pursue realization of child rights. We had precious time with ups and downs in the past 10 months. Until now upon official appointment, we are still thinking of ways to progress our mission.

We are just teens with limited ability; we doubt rather our action, such as posting articles in social media network, would bring actual changes to children's life. Are we too idealistic?

No, we strongly believe that every single action is one of the parts that contributes to the dramatic change. If we are devoting to our mission, one day we could build an utopia where puts children first.

This publication captured the important moments of our experience in the programme's 10-month training. Although this year's programme came to the end, the learning for us would be life-long. This publication will always remind us our mission, as well as our determination to fight for equality and justice.



#### 計劃簡介

#### 我們的工作

聯合國兒童基金會(UNICEF)透過各方面的工作,致力促進每一名兒童的權利和福祉。我們與合作伙伴在190個國家和地區工作,以實際行動兑現承諾,並特別關注和幫助最脆弱及被排斥的兒童,令所有兒童,不論身處何地,都能受惠。

聯合國兒童基金香港委員會(UNICEF HK)成立於1986年,是一個獨立的本地非政府組織,主要透過向公眾籌募捐款、與私人機構建立伙伴關係、籌辦特別活動等不同途徑,支持聯合國兒童基金會的工作。UNICEF HK同時亦藉着在港舉辦各項教育和青少年計劃,向公眾宣揚及倡議兒童權利。

#### 聯合國兒童基金會青年使者計劃

「聯合國兒童基金會青年使者計劃」自1996年由UNICEF HK成立至今,一直為本地青年人提供寶貴的學習機會,讓他們了解本地及世界各地與兒童生存、受保護、發展及參與權利有關的議題。每年仍有590萬名兒童活不過5歲生日,而大部份死亡個案是可以預防的。透過是項計劃,本港青年人能更了解全球兒童所面對的困難和挑戰,及與 UNICEF HK 攜手為兒童「零」受苦的目標而努力。表現出色的青年使者將有機會遠赴發展中國家考察。

- · 透過發展領袖能力、溝通技巧、組織及動員力等一系列訓練, 培育兒童權利倡議領袖
- · 喚起青年使者對發展中地區兒童的關注,了解他們所面對的挑戰及威脅及 UNICEF 的工作 如何改善兒童的生活
- ·提供平台予青年使者參與及推動 UNICEF HK 的倡議及教育工作
- · 實踐兒童參與權及推廣聯合國《兒童權利公約》



#### Programme Introduction

#### **Our Work**

UNICEF promotes the rights and wellbeing of every child, in everything we do. Together with our partners, we work in 190 countries and territories to translate that commitment into practical action, focusing special effort on reaching the most vulnerable and excluded children, to the benefit of all children, everywhere.

Hong Kong Committee for UNICEF (UNICEF HK) was founded in 1986 and was established as an independent local non-government organization to raise funds through public donations, partnerships with companies, special events, etc. to support UNICEF's work. UNICEF HK also promotes and advocates for children's rights via organizing education and youth programmes in Hong Kong.

#### **UNICEF Young Envoys Programme**

UNICEFYoung Envoys Programme, launched by UNICEF HK in 1996, aims to provide a valuable opportunity for youngsters to explore global and local issues in relation to children's rights to survival, protection, development and participation around the world. Currently, there are still 5.9 million children not reaching their fifth birthday every year, and the majority of those deaths are preventable. The Programme enables local youngsters to better understand the difficulties and challenges children facing globally, and to partner with UNICEF to achieve the goal of ZERO suffering for children. Outstanding Young Envoys will be granted an opportunity to visit UNICEF work in the field in a developing country.

#### **Objectives**

- To cultivate child rights advocates through capacity and skill building in terms of leadership, communication, organizing and mobilizing
- To raise awareness of the challenges and threats facing children in developing countries and how UNICEF improves lives of millions of children
- To offer a platform for young leaders to participate in and lead UNICEF HK's advocacy and education works
- To realise right to participation and promote United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child

在訓練過程中,青年使者深入探討了各項與兒童有關的本地及國際議題;亦於56間所屬學校裏,一手一腳舉辦了超過100項教育及籌募活動;更於暑假期間遠赴中國內地雲南省及柬埔寨考察,詳細了解兩地兒童及婦女的生活狀況及UNICEF的前綫工作。考察之旅為他們打開面向世界的一扇窗,豐富了他們的見識,更令他們真切體會到為何UNICEF堅持倡議兒童權利,令他們由心而發,成為兒童權利倡議者。

計算今屆青年使者在內,自1996年創立以來,UNICEF HK 已透過「聯合國兒童基金會青年 使者計劃」培訓過千名青年領袖,每年向超過3萬名中學生推廣兒童權利,為兒童發聲。

我們相信,世界不應只由成人主導;只要為兒童及年輕人締造合適的平台,並與他們結為 伙伴,他們的創新思維能為社會注入的新能量,其影響力將不可估量。

最後我謹代表本會答謝AEON信貸財務(亞洲)有限公司過去8年及來年的慷慨贊助,以及聯合國兒童基金會駐中國辦事處和駐柬埔寨辦事處的悉心安排,使今屆計劃的海外考察活動得以順利進行。

Including the batch of the Young Envoys appointed in this year, we have trained over 1,000 Young Envoys to be youth leaders since the launch of UNICEFYoung Envoys Programme in 1996. And every year we promote children's rights to over 30,000 secondary school students.

We believe the world's change makers are not just adults. By creating suitable platforms to engage children and young people to be our partners, we can leverage their innovative ideas in re-energizing and influencing our society.

Last but not least, I would like to take this opportunity to express our sincere gratitude to AEON Credit Service (Asia) Co., Ltd for their generous sponsorship of the programme for eight consecutive years and the coming year. Special thanks also go to UNICEF China and UNICEF Cambodia for their kind arrangement of the field visits.

We cannot say we made the wisest decisions, but we all understood that we have tried our best. After all, there were still rooms for improvement. Nevertheless, we believe that the participants' experiences were positive, and were shown from their smiles.

# Room Escape

### 聯校推廣活動 - 「逃出密室」

在「逃出密室」聯校推廣活動中,我們透過 逃離密室的遊戲模式模擬兒童被禁錮成童工 及奴隸的情況,讓參加者體會箇中感受。對 於參加者而言,這可能只是個遊戲。但現實 中卻有很多兒童是被拐帶或販賣,然後被逼 為奴,有着非一般的人生。

參加者在伸手不見五指和充滿障礙物的密室中,限時完成各種與兒童權利有關的任務。 我們相信活動經驗對參加者而言是刻骨銘心的,能讓他們反思捍衛兒童權利的重要性。







# Joint School Project - Room Escape

With the rising popularity of an incredibly sadistic game that locks people in and gives them a time limit to escape from the room, we have decided to create a similar replica for our joint school project to relay the trapped feeling that child slaves feel. Though it might be just a game to the participants, it is the reality of a great number of children kidnapped or forced into slavery.

Who could forget such a thrilling experience? A room dark lined with wires, numerous amount of puzzle to solve with several torches as their only source of illumination. From 'brain'-filled buckets to hidden keys and child-right related crosswords, the fear eats away their hearts as the clock ruthlessly ticks on. It must have been a time of their lives and an incredible chance to acknowledge the importance of safeguarding children's rights.





### Field Visit - Cambodia

The trip was definitely a life-changing experience to us, as we not only learnt about UNICEF's work in Cambodia but also the lives of children there. We had the opportunity to meet the local staff of UNICEF Cambodia, and got to know about the challenges they were facing, and how they solved them. For instance, how UNICEF Cambodia worked with the local government and other NGOs, providing training to local organizations to improve their service quality. All in all, we had a great time meeting the local staffs.

## 兒童友好校園

### **Child Friendly School**

When we visited the Preach Norodom Primary School, we were overwhelmed by the kids' passionate welcoming. This school was a model for Child Friendly Schools in Cambodia, established with the assistance and advice from UNICEF. This school displayed a great contrast between the students in Hong Kong and Cambodia. Kids were extremely friendly

to us and we all enjoyed chatting with each other. They treasured their time in school and made the fullest of it, as they all understood that enrolling into a school was a valuable opportunity.



### 兒童保護中心

柬埔寨的 Mith Samlanh Center 是一所提供職業訓練的中心,該中心會派出外展社工,拯救區內的街童及正受剝削或虐待的兒童。 14歲以下的兒童將會被安排於中心內上課,學習柬埔寨話、英語和數學。14至25歲的青年可根據其意願報讀為期約九個月的職業訓練課程,其中包括電器維修、車輛維修、烹飪、化妝美容及理髮等,學員亦有機會於中心營運的社會企業實習。修畢課程及通過考試後,中心會推薦學員到不同公司工作。此外,中心亦提供免費的基本醫療服務。

#### **Child Protection Center**

The Mith Samlanh Centre offers career training by sending outreach social workers to rescue children within the community on the streets or under abuse. Children under 14 are scheduled to lessons within the center, learning "Khmer" (Cambodian language), English and Mathematics. Youth aged between 14 and 25 can apply for a 9-month training course, including appliance repair, car repair, cookery,

cosmetics use, hairdressing and more; these students would have the opportunity to work as intern within the center. When students complete their courses, they are tested and if they are qualified, they would be recommended to different companies. In addition, the center offers simple, free basic medical services to its users.











### 磅湛省醫院及上丁省醫院

考察醫院的其中一個重點, 是一個由 UNICEF 協助建成 的遊戲室,讓病患兒童舒 病患及治療過程所帶來病 力和負能量。受愛滋病的 動學 可在接受治療前玩樂 低他們的恐懼和心理壓力, 即使是沒有患病的兒童也可 以到這裏聽故事。同時,院 方會為家長提供烹飪課程, 教授他們煮一些簡單並有營 養的食物以幫助復原。

醫院因得到資助,可以為受 愛滋病病毒感染的人士提供 免費治療。「防治母嬰感染 愛滋病病毒」服務計劃更可 以大大減低嬰兒從母體感染 愛滋病的機會75%至10%。 UNICEF還會為居住在偏遠地 方但需要定期覆診的患者提 供交通津貼。

# Kampong Cham Provincial Hospital and Streng Treng Hospital

In the hospitals we had visited, there was a playground room supported by UNICEF. Children and patients could relieve their stress there during their stays in the hospital. Children with HIV/AIDS or any other diseases can enjoy themselves before treatments, thus their fear and psychological stress would be lessened before meeting doctors. At the same time, the hospitals would offer culinary lessons to parents, showing them how to prepare simple but nutritious diets to foster recovery.

With financial aid from UNICEF, the hospitals provided free treatment for patients with HIV/AIDS. For example, mothers with HIV/AIDS could receive Prevention of Mother-to-Child Transmission (PMTCT) treatment, which lowers the possibility of their children getting HIV/AIDS from 75 per cent to 10 per cent. In addition, UNICEF would provide transportation allowance for patients who were living in remote areas, to ensure continuity of treatment.







#### 供水、環境衞生和個人衞生 (WASH)項目



上丁省缺乏完善的供水系統,當地居民大多從附近的河或井取水使用。未經過濾的水大多含有大腸桿菌及其他污染物,而部分水更因受鉀污染,因此不宜飲用。UNICEF 資助興建濾水站,並向附近居民以市價三成的價格出售食水,讓附近的居民

有能力購買安全食水。同時,附近學校得到安全食水,大大減低學童患病的機會,學生的課堂出席率因而得到提升。UNICEF亦資助學校興建廁所及收集雨水的設施,學生可用收集得來的雨水於如廁後及進食前洗手。







# Water & Sanitation Hygiene (WASH) Programme

As Streng Treng Province lacks a complete water supply system, most of the locals would draw water from nearby rivers and wells. Most rivers' water are contaminated by Escherichia coli and other contaminants; and arsenic in well water is harmful to human. UNICEF has funded the construction of a filtering station, to supply water with 30 per cent of market price, so that nearby villagers could consume

affordable and safe drinking water. Also, since schools nearby are supplied with safe drinking water, the chance of students falling ill from foul water and the school attendance improved. In addition, UNICEF has also funded the establishment of toilets and rain collection facilities at schools, to collect water to flush toilets or wash hands before meals.







#### 中國貧困地區社會發展計劃

計劃旨在向農村婦女提供小額信貸資金,讓 她們可使用該信貸資金來從事具生產力的經 濟活動,如養雞、種特定的農作物等,以增 加家庭收入,達至減少貧窮的發展性目標。 計劃最初是由 UNICEF 駐中國辦事處與政府 合作在雲南省試行,有助提升婦女綜合質素、能力及家庭地位,並改變傳統「男主外, 女主內」的觀念,加強婦女的創業能力,因 成效甚佳,現在已由政府主理及推行。

# Social Development Programme for Poor Areas in China (SPPA)

The programme provides loans to village women, so that they could have capital for investment and run economically-productive activities in order to reduce poverty. It was originally piloted by UNICEF China. It alternated people's traditional thoughts toward

women, improved women's capability to run business and their family status. As there were profound outcomes, the Government took over the programme and ran by themselves.

#### 供水、環境衞生和個人衞生 (WASH)項目


這全球項目為發展中的國家的居民建造廁 所、安裝沖廁系統、提供符合安全標準的 飲用水及培養居民衞生意識。我們到雲南 省進行實地考察時發現,當地居民都十分 了解「洗手6步曲」,衞生意識有所提高, 能夠減少患病機會。可見這個 UNICEF 的計 劃在當地起了非常明顯的成效。

# Water & Sanitation Hygiene (Wash) Programme

This global programme helps build toilets, drainage system and provide safe water in less developed countries. It also educates local villagers to develop the practice of using toilet and washing hands. In the field visit to Yunnan Province, we found that the villagers were familiar with the "6 steps of

washing hands", meaning that the hygiene awareness had been raised, and thus the risks of the illness were lowered. It showed that this UNICEF programme had achieved great success in China.

#### 家訪

我們探訪了好幾個住在山邊的家庭。其中一個家庭有兩個分別七歲和五個月大的小朋友。七歲的小朋友正就讀小學,然而他日後可能要輟學,因為那裏附近並沒有中學。

提起山區,我們可能只想到惡劣的居住環境,卻常忽略了當地兒童的學習需要。貧窮地區的兒童得不到適切的教育,形成跨代貧窮的惡性循環。我們相信向大眾推廣「均等」的理念及向貧困兒童提供教育,才能夠徹底解決他們的貧窮問題和改變他們的命運。

經過三個小時顛簸的山路後,我們到達鳴音鎮, 我們再花了四十五分鐘,徒步走進村落,進行家 訪。映入眼簾的是無數團團轉的蒼蠅,展望過去 有數隻家畜,雞、牛都不缺。再走進去,便看到 有一位年約四十多歲的中年男子帶著一個大約一 歲多的小孩。

大家寒暄數句,再談談關於有條件現金轉移計劃和 UNICEF 對他們的幫助。從他們的口中,我們得知有條件現金轉移計劃對他們來說,最重要的不是那九百多塊的現金資助,而是他們透過這個計劃認識到更加多關於孕婦應該要注意的事情,而且這個計劃也給了孕婦動力,定期到醫院作產前檢查,使整個懷孕及生育的過程變得安全。那個家庭提及孩子的媽媽在生第一胎的時候,並不知道要到醫院作檢查的重要性,就連分娩也是在家。他說直至孩子的媽媽再度懷孕,並接受了這個計劃的資助,到醫院檢查時才知道懷孕時有很多需要注意的地方,並感謝UNICEF的資助和教育工作。

四十五分鐘的山路對我們來說已經是叫苦連天,當知道他們每次要看病時也要走過這崎嶇山路時我們已立刻問他們:「病了也要走這山路,不辛苦嗎?」他呆了呆,然後才答:「啊,不,不辛苦,四十五分鐘而已。」我們才醒覺,對啊,這是他們每天生活的一部分,怎會覺得辛苦呢!只嘆自己不太吃得苦。後來他們分享到大兒子已經是初中生,由家到學校的路程要達三小時,故大兒子是在學校寄宿的。

後來,他很熱情地邀請我們吃頓家常飯,順便可以跟他的大兒子與老婆談談天。這頓飯雖不是我們吃過最好吃的一頓,但一邊吃飯,一邊談天,沒有人低頭看手機,大家的年齡也不一樣,但樂也融融。他們不是什麼富足人家,但卻不斷給我們添菜,生怕我們吃不飽似的,那種熱情的好客之道也教我們有點慚愧。他們沒有豐富的物質生活,但掛在他們面上的那種純粹的笑容,已是他們快樂的最佳證明。這些特質,正是我們需要學習的地方吧。







#### **Home Visit**

We visited a family who lived in the hillside. The family has two children, who are aged 7 and 5 months respectively. The elder one is attending primary school, yet there were no "secondary schools" nearby, thus it implied that the chance for education would be ceased if parents could not afford the transportation. The problems we might think of people living the remote areas were inconvenient transport and poor living environment. Yet, education was also a huge problem. Without proper education, the intergenerational cycle of poverty would continue. However, we do believe it is paramount to have equity in society and to provide equal access to education for poor children in order to break the poverty cycle.

After three hours of a very bumpy ride through the mountains, we arrived at Ming Yin Village, and after a forty-five minute walk from the carpark we gazed upon place we were going to conduct our visits. Numerous amounts of flies seems to be everywhere, placing our gaze further, there were a couple of livestock. We met an adult in mid-forties and his 1-year-old son.

Exchanging pleasantries, our discussion quickly turned towards the Conditional Cash Transfer (CCT) programme and the help UNICEF has given them. We learnt that the CCT programme was incredibly important to them not because of the financial support of RMB 900, but the healthcare knowledge they gained of what pregnant women should be aware of and avoid. In addition to that, the CCT programme motivated pregnant women to visit the hospital regularly for prenatal checkup, and because they are aware of the

importance and they would like to be safe in the pregnancy and in the birth-giving process.

When the boy's mother was in her first pregnancy, she was unaware of the importance of regular prenatal checkup at the hospital, thus she even gave birth at home. When she got in touch with the CCT programme in her second pregnancy, she acknowledged the importance of regular prenatal checkups and giving birth at hospital. They were really thankful for UNICEF's help.

Walking for 45 minutes in the rugged road already made us felt annoyed and tired. When they said that they must walk the same path to visit doctor when they were sick, we immediately asked, "Having to walk so far and so long even when you're ill, isn't it exhausting and tough?" After a pause, he simply replied, "Oh, no, not at all, it's only forty five minutes after all." We suddenly acknowledged that this is part of their daily lives. Afterwards, the father shared that their eldest son was a middle school student, and must travel for three hours to school from where he lived; hence he lives at the school dorm.

Afterwards, the family prepared lunch for us. Although this would not be the most delicious meal that we ever had, the process was enjoyable. We talked, we shared, and we felt connected with each other. Their hospitability impressed us tons, they were eager to share with us the limited resources they had. They did not have as much resources as we did, but the smiles on their faces were the best proof of their definite happiness. This is exactly what we should learn from them.


